Australia Increases International Student Intake for 2026!

After two years of restricting international student numbers as part of broader migration reforms, the Australian Government is now shifting direction. In a major policy change, Australia will increase its international student intake by 25,000, bringing the total to 295,000 for 2026.

This marks a renewed commitment to welcoming international students and it opens up greater opportunities not just to study in Australia, but to build a long-term future here.

What's Changing in 2026?
Both higher education and vocational education and training (VET) sectors will benefit from this increased cap.

To improve student progression and support long-term pathways, two groups of students will no longer count towards institutional soft caps:

- Students who complete high school in Australia
- Students who progress from pathway colleges

These exemptions make it easier for continuing students to transition into higher qualifications and stay longer in Australia.
