Update: 2025-26 Work and Holiday (Subclass 462) Visa Caps

As of July 2025, the Australian Government has introduced revised annual caps for first-time Work and Holiday (subclass 462) visas, with limits varying by country. These caps are set by the Department of Home Affairs at the beginning of each program year, which runs from 1 July to 30 June.

Countries such as Argentina and Chile still have places available, while some others have already reached their caps and had applications paused. A notable update this year is the increase in Indonesia's cap, which has risen from 1,500 to 5,000—reflecting stronger cooperation and growing demand.

For high-demand countries like China, India, and Vietnam, a ballot system has been introduced. Applicants must register, and selected individuals will be invited to apply in phases until 30 April 2026. This new process is designed to manage demand more fairly and improve transparency.

Second and third Work and Holiday visas remain uncapped and available to eligible applicants.

Why it matters:

- **Builds trust**: Shows you're clear and professional about your work rights.
- Speeds up hiring: Employers can quickly see if you're eligible.
- Keeps you in the running: Missing visa info may get your CV skipped.
- Opens sponsorship doors: Transparency can lead to long-term opportunities like the 482 visa.
