IMPORTANT POLICY UPDATE: KEY MIGRATION ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM MINISTER TONY BURKE 19 SEP 2026

HERE IS WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- **Ban on Student Visa Dependants:** New international students and graduate visa holders will no longer be permitted to attach family members or dependants to their visas. Those already in Australia with dependants will be allowed to stay.
- **Working Holiday Visas:** Completing 88 days of regional work will no longer automatically guarantee a second-year visa. Applicants will now enter a ballot system for extensions.
- **Student Integrity Controls:** Stricter rules will prevent onshore "course swapping" and bridging visa misuse.
- **Focus on Skilled Trades:** Increased prioritization for construction and trade workers to support national housing supply.
